ALL GRADES: All children must have a book bag. Children must have rubber-soled gym shoes (that do not leave black marks) to wear on gym days. Please mark book bags and clothing with your child's name. NO TRAPPER KEEPERS for Kindergarten through Fifth Grades, and no rolling backpacks for Third through Fifth Grades.

All incoming K - 6th grade new students will need a personal set of headphones. The school can order a pair for you or you are welcome to supply your own. Earbuds are not recommended.
